- COUNTING: 12345 once I caught a fish alive **DENISE**; This old man
- COUNTING-OUT: Eeny meeny miny, moe (**My mom told me...**) **JAN**; One flew over the cuckoo's nest (**3 geese in a flock, one flew east...**) **TERÉZIA**

- FAMILY LIFE IN VICTORIAN TIMES: Polly put the kettle on; Dance to your daddy my little laddie **ESTELA**
- BEDTIME: Twinkle twinkle **ELIŠKA**
- LULLABIES: Hush little baby don't say a word; Hush-a-bye don't you cry (for brilliant singers), Rock-a-bye baby **EMA**

- TROUBLE-MISHAP: Jack and Jill **MARTIN**; Little boy blue, **5 LITTLE MONKEYS**
- OCCUPATIONAL: Pat-a-cake; Cobbler cobbler
- ANIMALS: Baa baa black sheep **NATÁLIE**; Old McDonald **FILIP**; Incy wincy spider **DANIELA M**, Mary had a little lamb, Who's afraid of the big bad wolf/Virginia Wolf **DANIELA L**
- ACTION: London Bridge is falling down **LUCIA**; I'm a little teapot



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- ROUNDS: London's burning; Row row row your boat **MICHAELA+KATKA**
- FOOD: Some like it hot **SYLVA**/Pease porridge hot; Little Miss Muffet; Oranges and Lemons
- SEASONAL: Hot cross buns, Christmas is coming **DENISA**
- LIMERICKS: There was an old man with a beard; There was a young lady from Niger


