## **Poetry**

**Poetic diction** - established literary vocabulary. Considerably expanded in the  $20^{\rm th}$  century - included regional and social dialectisms, slang, taboo words, etc. Traditionally:

- archaisms (yonder, hither, quoth, thee)
- poetic expressions (i.e. poetically restricted words) (woe, billows, nymph, o'er)
- neologisms

Deviance from standard lexical structures → to create specific meanings.

Grammatical deviance (Wordsworth: *I to her cottage bent my way ...*This child I to myself will take ...

A slumber did my spirit seal ...)
