"Placet hen is an important koncept for geography. It overlaps with and sometimes substitutes for other key terms such as region, area and landscape but still aids a dimension of its own. Place can be studied in its own right as an identifiable segment of the Earth's surface with particular set of identifying features. It can also be seen as a minor of society, reflecting both the history and distributions of power of the kontext in witch it has emerged. Place for geographers is part of the Earth's surface with a spatial identity and boundaries that separate it from other places. Some places are very crearly defined in these terms; others are more opaque (from Matthews,J. and Herbert,D. 2004, *Unifing Geography*, Abingdon: Routlege, p. 168).
