• 4 types:

ZERO conditional

FIRST conditional

SECOND conditional

THIRD conditional

FIRST conditional

• use:

- spekulujeme o možných situacích, které se skutečně mohou stát
- mluvíme o budoucnosti

if-clause main clause

present tense will + inf.

If it rains tomorrow, we will stay at home.

SECOND conditional

• use:

- spekulujeme o situacích, které jsou málo pravděpodobné
- mluvíme o přítomnosti či budoucnosti

if-clause main clause

past tense would + inf.

If someone pointed a gun at me, I'd be very frightened.
If I were you, I wouldn't cheat.

- apart from (= except)
- to have (a) difficulty with st. /to have (a) difficulty in doing st.
- to be responsible for (doing) st.
- to pay attention to st.
- to be good at st.
- to be unusual for sb. to do st.
- in case + present simple
- to feel like doing st.
- to be impossible for sb. to do st.
- to look forward to (doing) st.
- don't have to
- to blame sb. for st.
- to have/get st. done

Useful structures

- in order to do st.
- there's no chance of st./doing st
- there is no point (in) st./doing st
- there is nothing left
- you had better do st.
- mind doing st.
- give sb. permission to do st.
- get used to st./doing st. x be used to st./doing st.
- besides st./ besides doing st.
