3. Connect labels to the images of the instructions for proper condom handling.



Attach the condom to the erect penis with the foreskin retracted before any contact occurs between the penis and the partner's body.

After ejaculation, hold the condom around the perimeter at the base of the penis and pull it out. Only then remove the condom. Be careful that the condom and the penis do not come into contact with the partner's body.

Tear the foil and carefully remove the condom so that it is not damaged by nails and other sharp objects.

Dispose of the used condom hygienically. Pack it in paper handkerchiefs and dispose of in a waste bin - do not flush into the toilet.

During sexual intercourse, make sure the condom is still attached. If the condom slides, adjust it accordingly. If a condom is being slipped off while making love, always use a new one.

Make sure the condom's side that can be rolled is outside. Hold the tip of the condom (2-3 cm) with your thumb and forefinger to expel the air and prevent the condom from breaking. Gently roll the condom down the entire length of the penis while still holding the tip of the condom.
