Teachers' competences: "an integrated set of personal characteristics, knowledge, skills and attitudes that are needed for effective performance in various teaching contexts"

- Knowledge and instructional expertise (teaching and learning) which include for example "knowledge of curriculum and subject matter" and "instructional planning and strategies" etc.
- **Organisation/management pedagogical expertise** which include managing students and learning environment etc.
- Diversity knowledge of diverse students, including special needs, and how they learn
- Partnering of parents, colleagues and community
- **Professional development attitude** including professional growth, resilience and adaptability, sense of self-efficacy or willingnes to try new ideas and strategies etc.
- Development of ethical stand exercising personal integrity and legal responsibilities
