



Table I Pharmacokinetics of the three PDE5 inhibitors<sup>14</sup>

Headache	14.6%	14.5%	14%
Flush	14.1%	11.1%	4%
Dyspepsia	6.2%	3.7%	10%
Rhinitis	2.6%	9.2%	5%
Back pain	0%	0%	6%
Visual disturbances	5.2%	0%	0%
