



# Cultural Communication Scorecard

The cultural communication scorecard (Schroevers, 2016) is a framework for cross-cultural communication allowing international comparison between cultures. Eight values drawn from different validated academic researches (Trompenaars, Hofstede, Hall, GLOBE, WVS, CPI) are placed on a spectrum, giving an estimate of the probability that a person from a specific culture will display a defined behaviour, despite the considerable differences between individuals. In this workshop we use the following spectra;
