

## U1 NOTES

Febris, is, F (dosis/basis) -fever

Genu, us, N – knee

Os, ossis, N – bone

Ós, óris, N – mouth

Preposition a+ a consonant- a tergo – from the back

Preposition ab+ vowel – ab ovo – from the eg (the beginning of life)

Narcosis, is, F – basis gen can have -eos = baseos, narcoseos...

All words ending in -sis, -xis, -osis F belong to basis: e.g. dosis, prophylaxis, nephrosis, narcosis

Amputatio sine narcosi, remedium contra febrim, emulsio pro usu veterinario, status post operationem, pro balneo externo, ex oculo sinistro, ad lagoenam puram, febris cum dolore.

Ex.1

State after collapse (breakdown) , remedy against vomiting, illness with fever, injection against pain, abortion (miscarriage) after a heavy trauma, pains before a surgery, massive infection in the abdominal region, the inflammation of the skin from the contact with acids, healing a defect, for a bath, by mouth, through the rectum, suppositories for infants, remedy for internal use, the biggest dose for a day, ointment for external use.

!!! we have 3 groups of words ending in -us in 1st sg:

Nervus, i,

Corpus, is

Ductus, us

It is the **genitive ending** that indicates which group the word belongs to!!!

!!two exceptions in gender in the 4th declension:

Manus, us, F – hand

Acus, us, F – needle

!!species – tea mixture (of herbs) – it is always used in plural: species cholagogae, species urologicae, species pectorales.

Articulatio – + 2nd of joint, genu – knee

Arcus + 2nd of plural

Fractura +2nd manus F=ductus!

Effectus +2nd PL

Sanatio +2nd abscessus=ductus

Collapsus +2nd systema= corpus, respiratorium=septum
