



## MYCENAEAN GREECE c. 1450-1150 B.C.




### MYCENAE THOLOS OR BEEHIVE TOMB LATE HELLADIC II-IIIA c 1520 - 1300 BC


Nine such plundered tombs were discovered at Mycenae all outside the fortification, little is known about their contents.

here at Mycenaean is the finest example.









