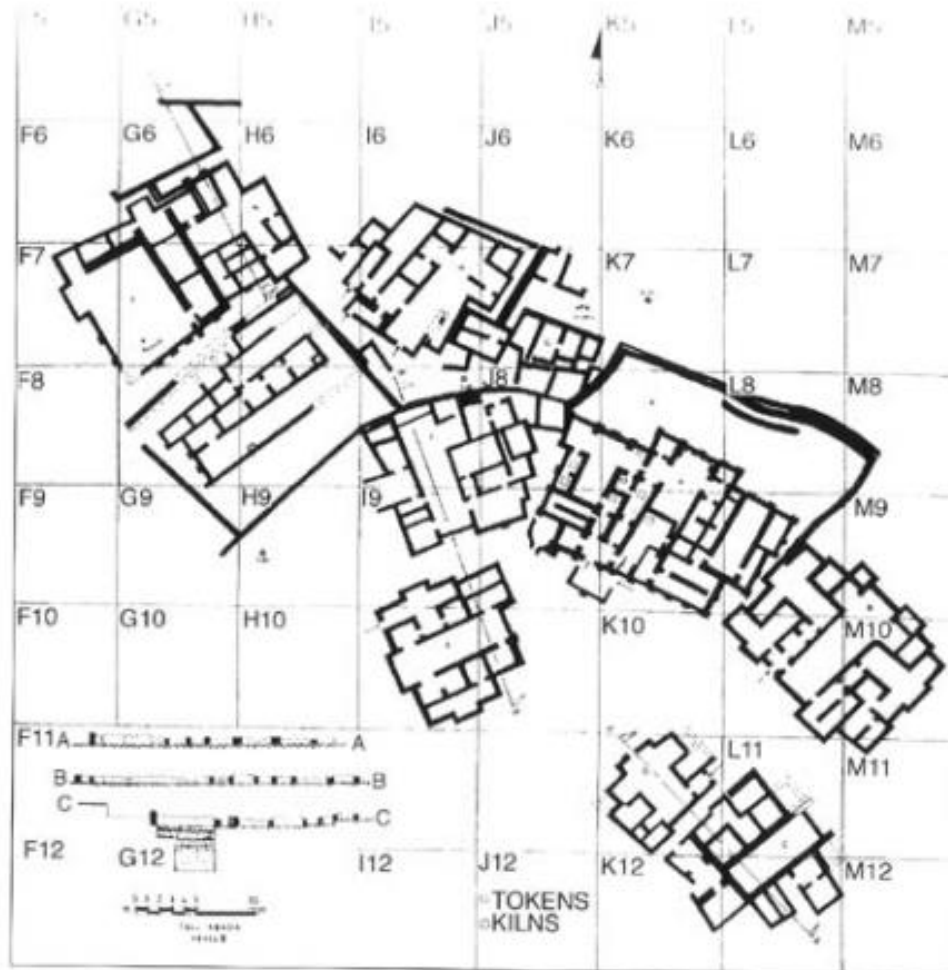
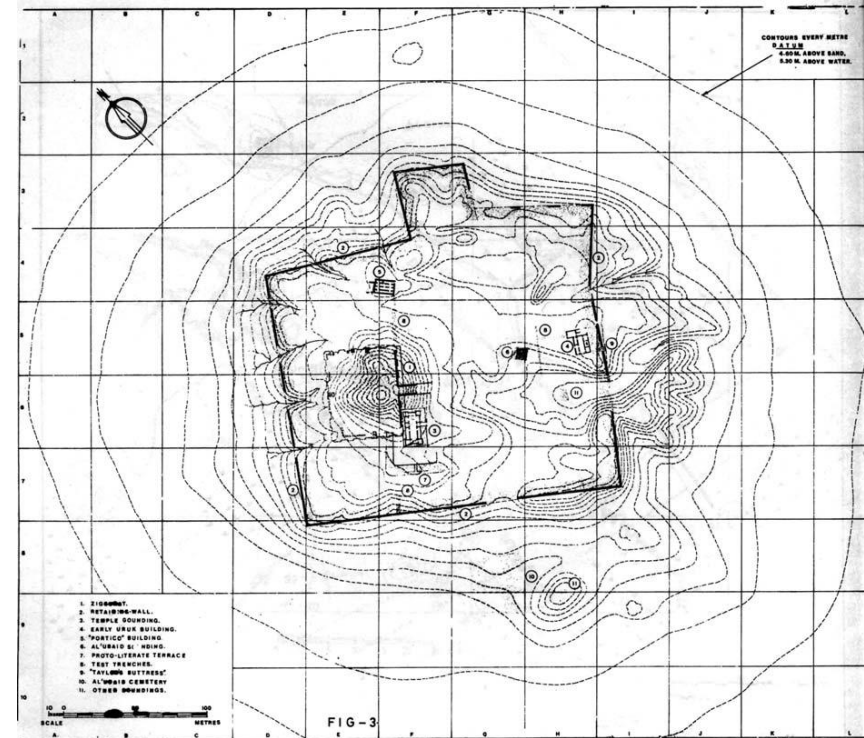
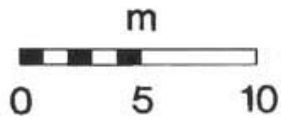
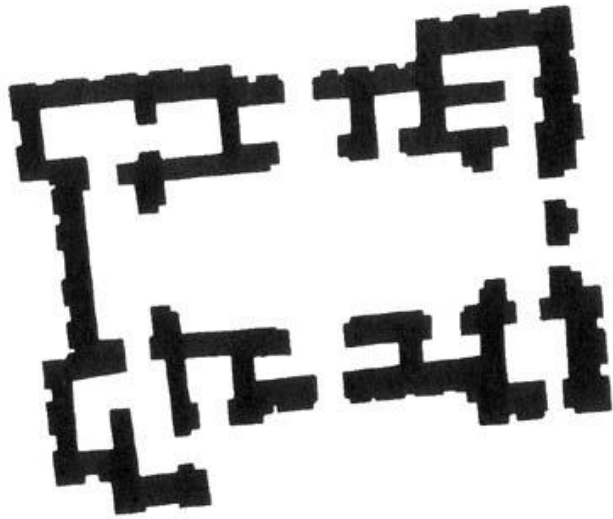


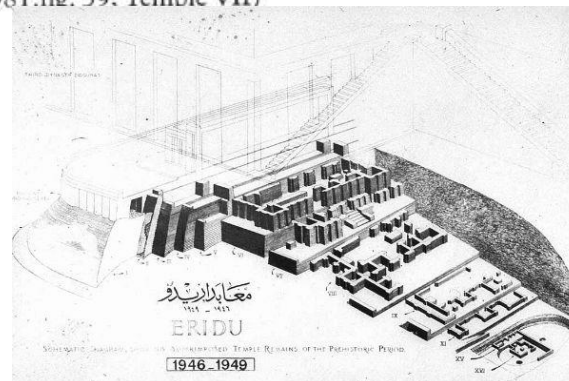
Figure 3.23 Plan of the Level II settlement at Tell Abada showing large houses tightly nucleated (early Ubaid 3)

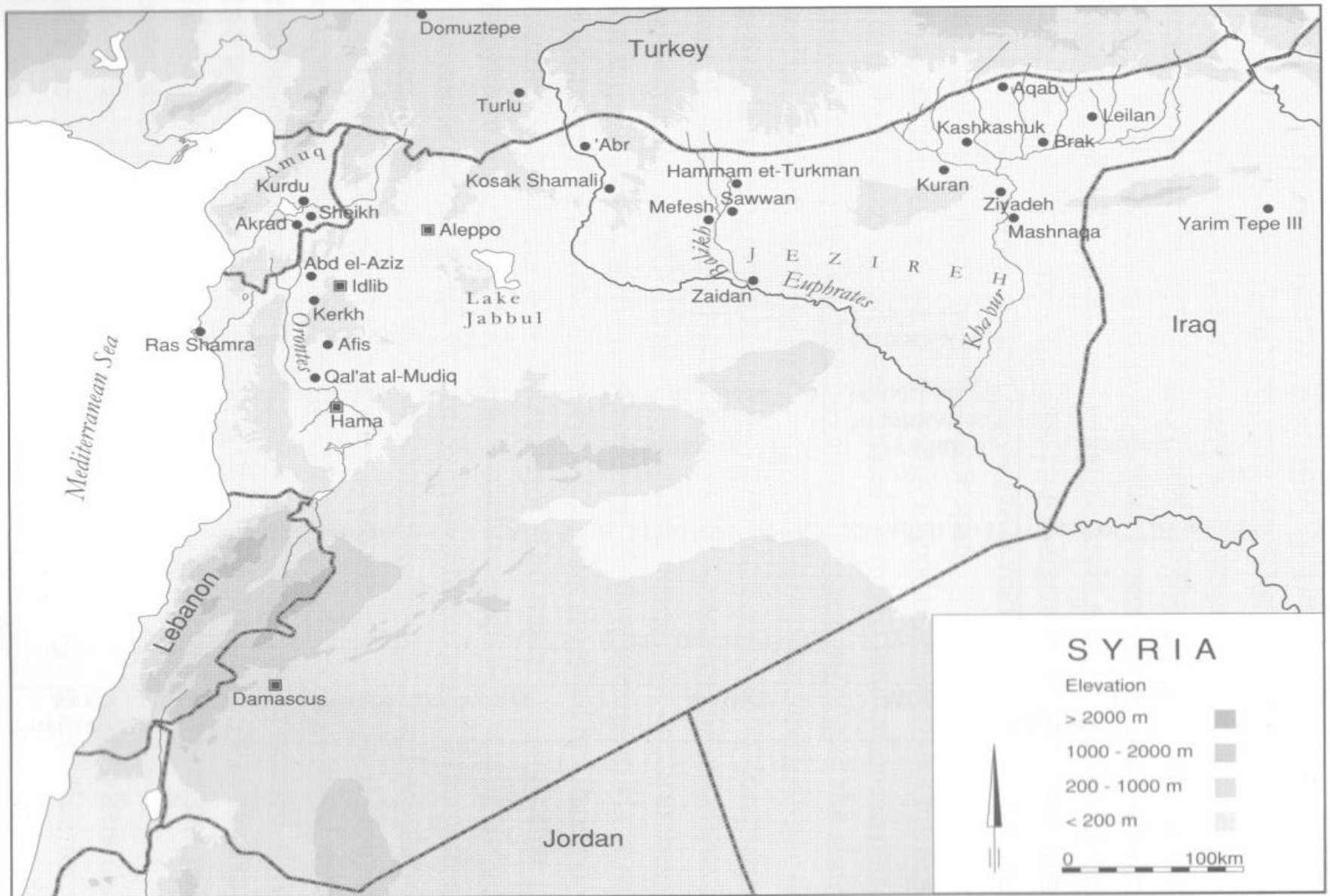
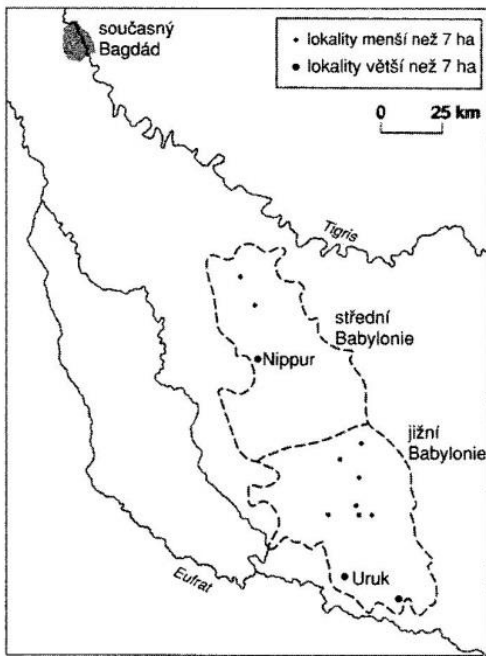
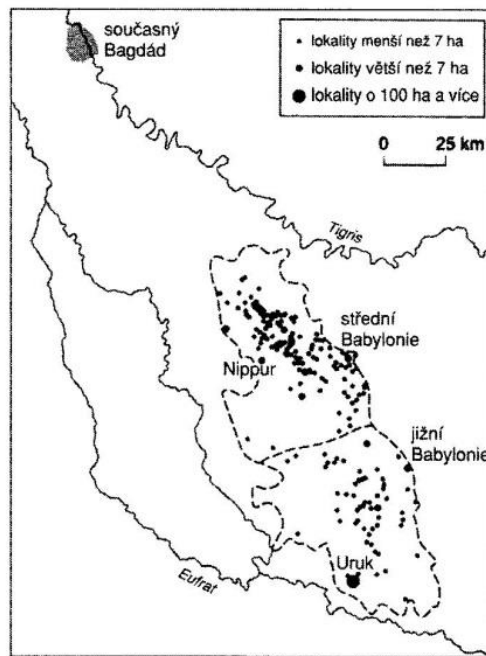


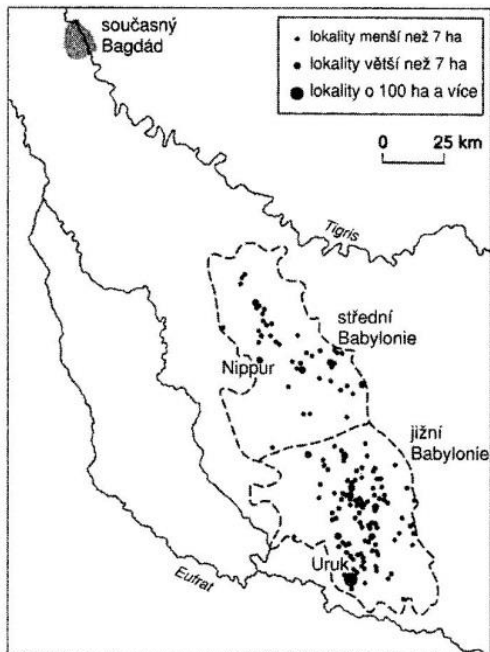
Fig. 5.1 Syria in the late sixth and fifth millennia BC, with the main Ubaid sites mentioned in the text.

(c) pozdní urucké období

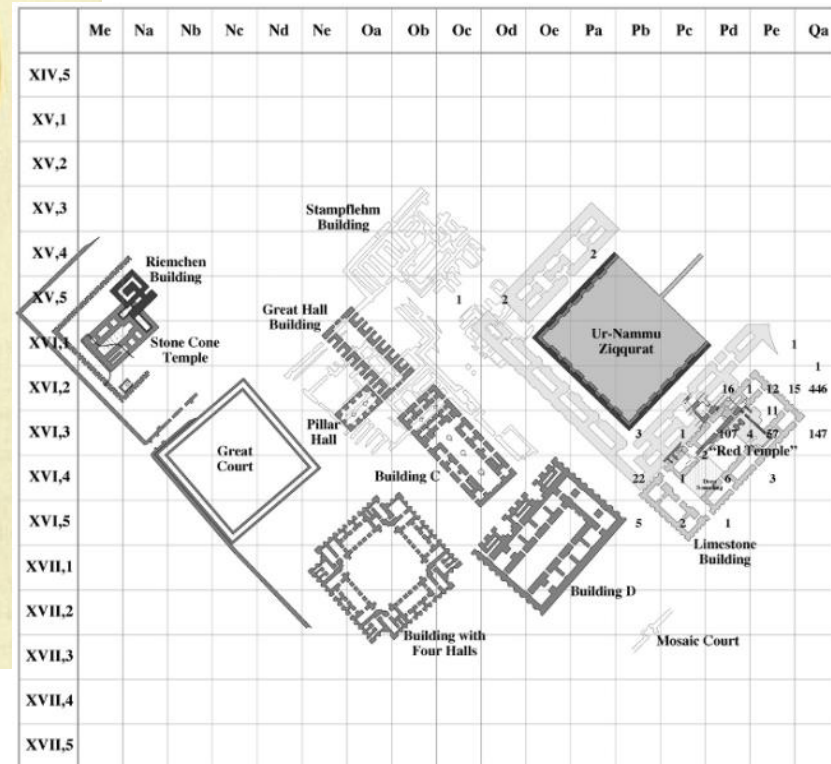
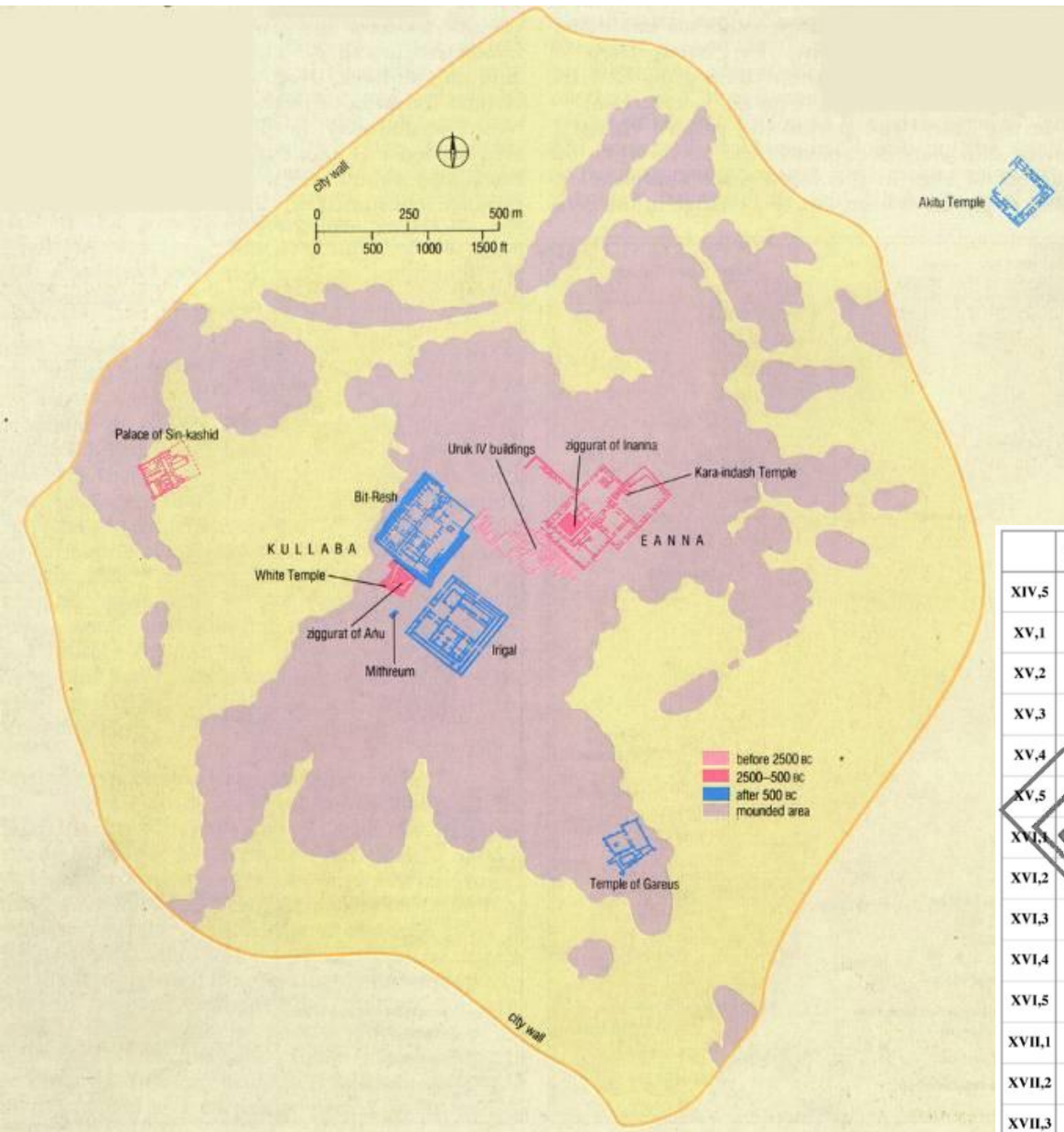

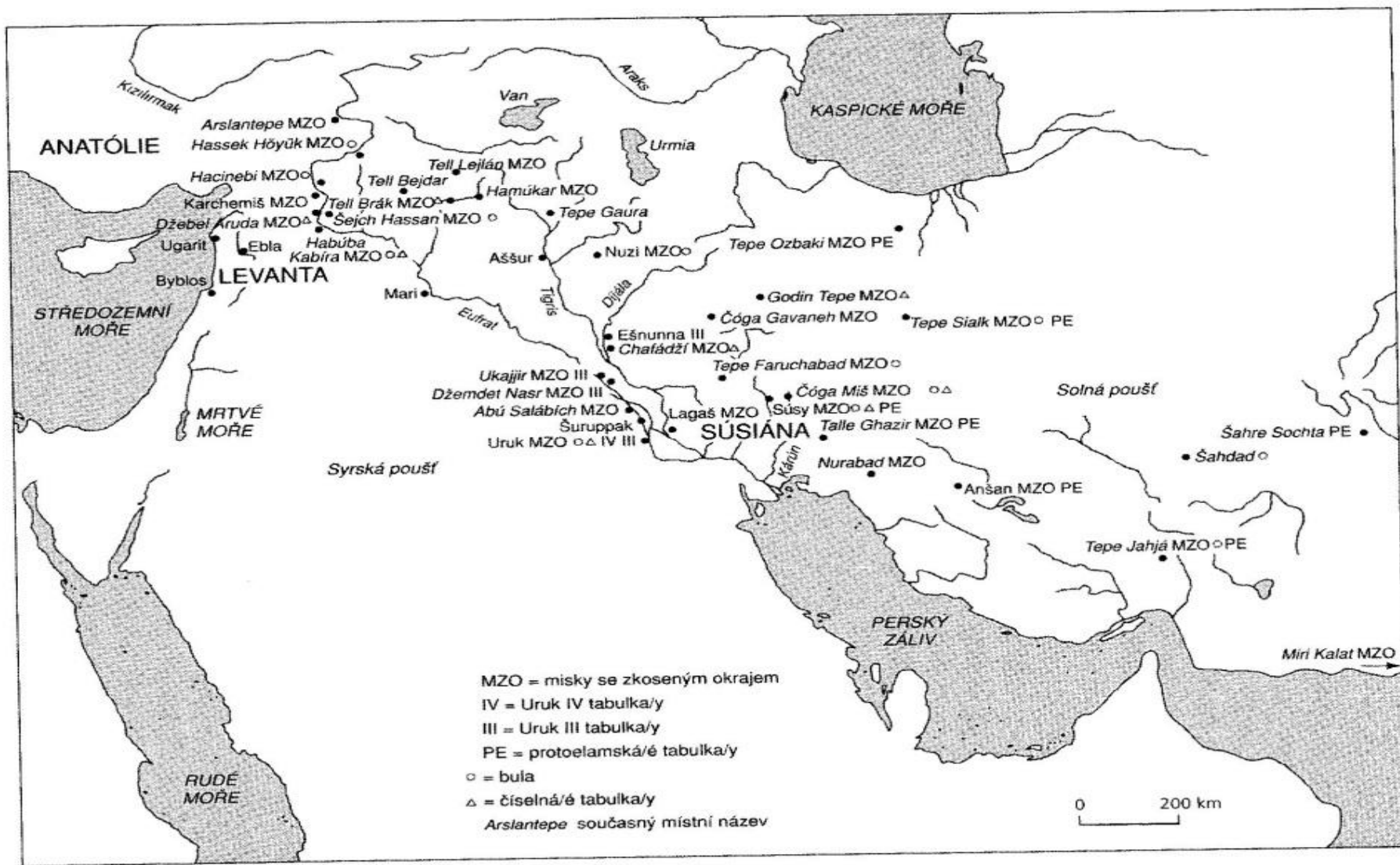

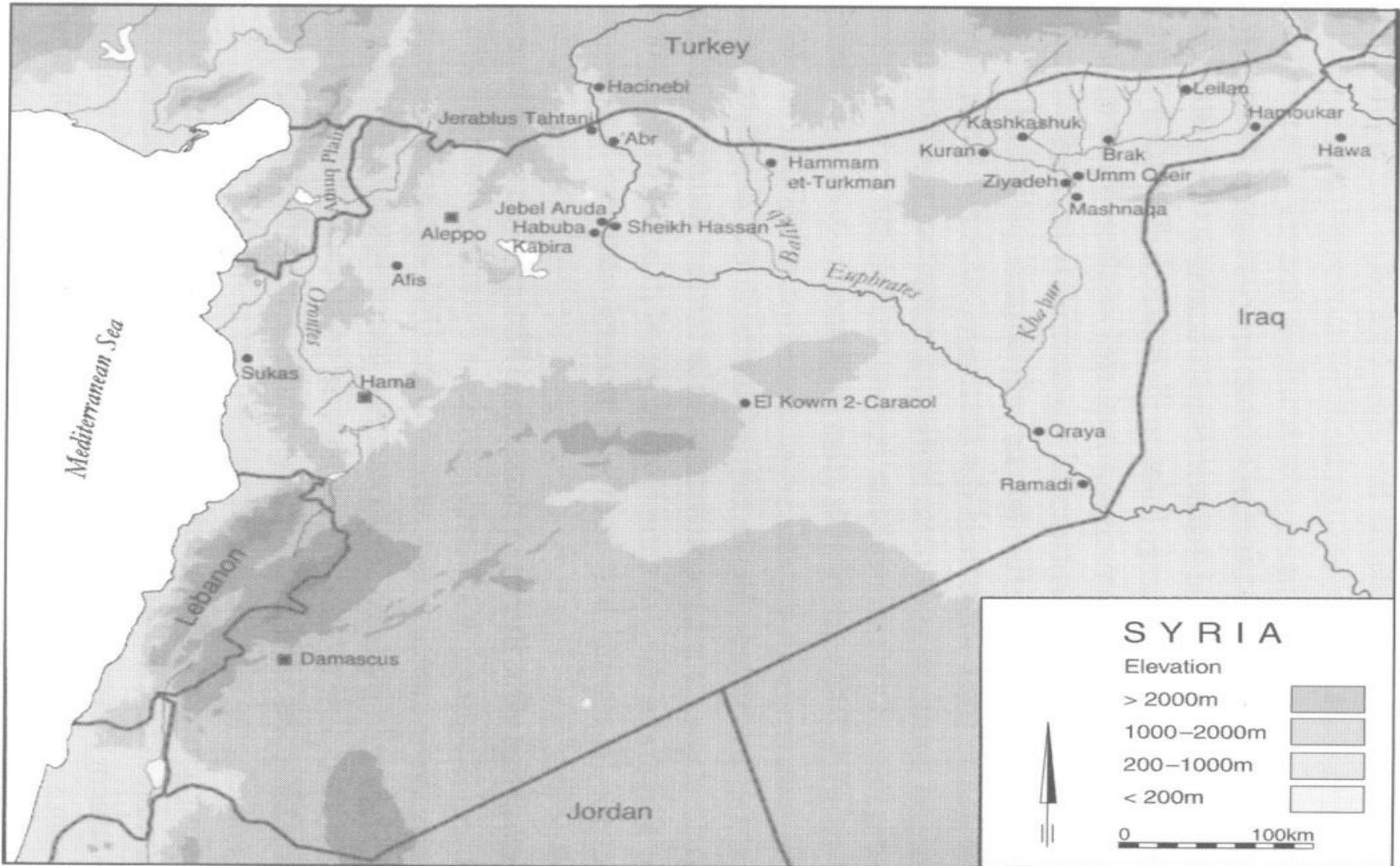
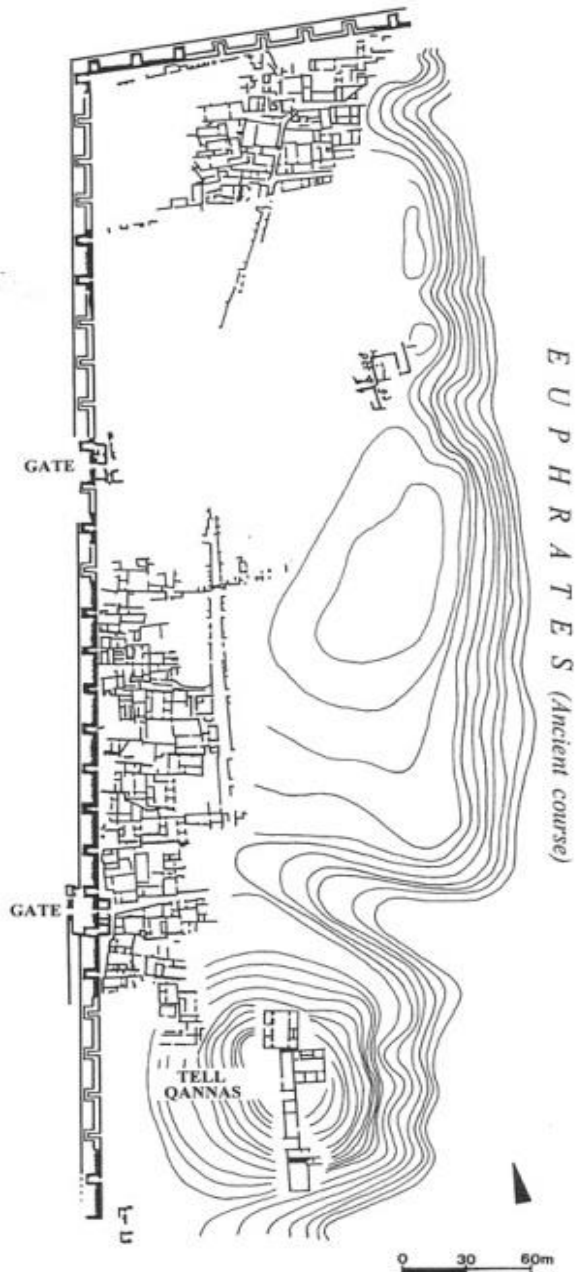


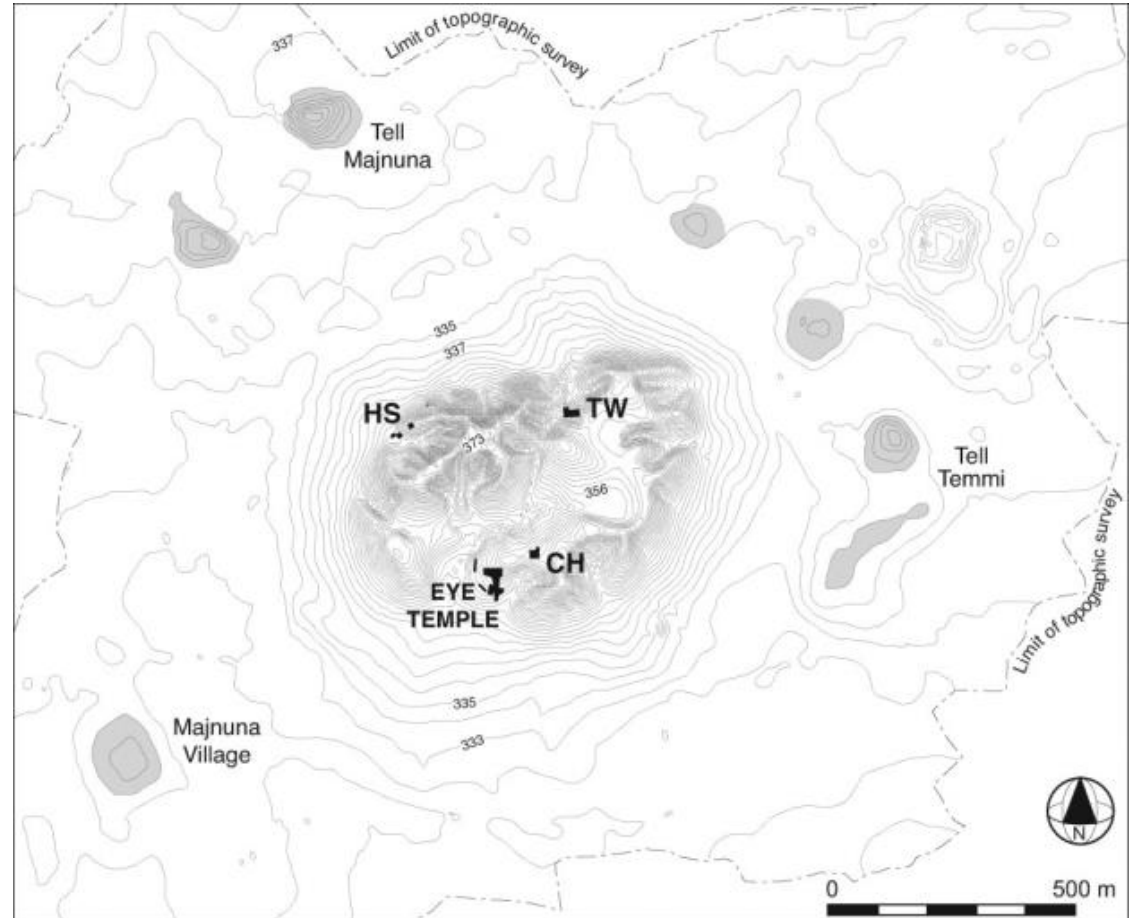
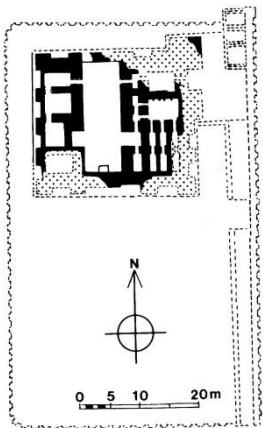
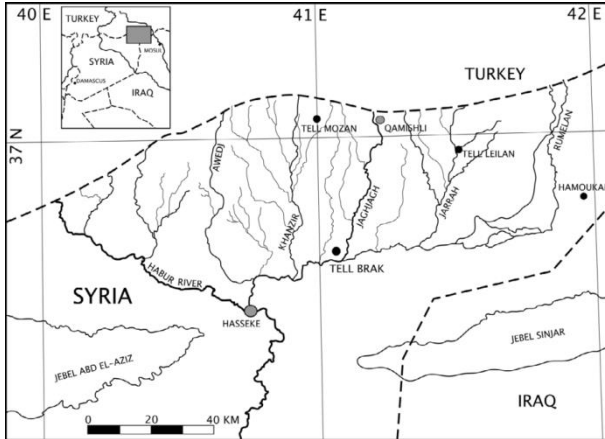
Fig. 6.1 Syria in the fourth millennium BC.
