1 <i>5</i> th April	Concepts of iconology: from visual lexicon to social memory <i>Task:</i> Outline the main ideas presented by Aby Warburg in the Introduction to <i>Mnemosyne</i> (uploaded on the folder for this week). How might they be relevant to the interpretation of Czech art?
