Past

가

Verb stem Go/[ga] Pre-final ending which represents tense

다

Ending of the word [da]

e.g. 선생님이 영어를 가르치셨어요

- 1. Stem : 가르치 → 치 is not bright vowel → past tense : 었
- 2. Honorific suffix :人
- 3. Speech level ending: 어요 (polite)
- 4. 가르치 + 시었 + 어요
- 5. 시었 → 셨
- =가르치셨어요

Bright vowel ㅏ (no final consonant)+ 았 +어요 🛶 갔

Ex. 나다(grow), 자다(sleep), 차다(kick) + 어요 \rightarrow 났어요, 잤어요, 찼어요





Bright vowel ㅗ (no final consonant) + 았 + 어요 🗪 옸

* Bright vowel ㅗ (no final consonant) : only 오다, 보다, 꼬다(twist), 쏘다(shoot), 쪼다(peck) Ex. 쏘다 → 쐈다

Bright vowel ├,ㅗ (with consonant)+ 았 + 어요 ⇒ 받았

Ex. 알다(know), 쏟다(spill)→ 알았다, 쏟았다

all other vowels +었 + 어요 🛶 먹었

Ex. 숨다(hide), 얼다(freeze) → 숨었다, 얼었다


Exercise 2. Change the following sentence into past tense and translate the sentences into English

Subtle differences

- English past tense represents what happened in the past
- Korean past tense not only <u>did it happen in the past</u>, also consider whether <u>an action or event is completed</u>





바지를 입었어요 [ba ji leul i beo sseo yo]

- 1) "(I) wore a pants"
- 2) "(I) am wearing a pants" (As a result of the complete action of wearing pants)

Exercise 3. Look at the following sentence and write two corresponding interpretations in English (1) 커피를 마셨어요. [keo pi leul ma syeo sseo yo]

- (I) drank coffee/ (I) am drinking coffee
- → (2) 한국어 수업 숙제를 했어요. [han gug eo su eob sug je leul hae sseo yo]
 - (I) did Korean class assignment./ (I) am doing Korean class assignment
