3. Language - appropriate to audience - explanation of jargon

- voice - speed

4. Body language - eye contact (with the whole class, not only the teacher)

- good use of notes; not reading large parts of the presentation

- stance, enthusiasm

5. Visuals (Optional) - appropriate

- supportive

- clear

6. Questions - handling of the discussion

- clear, appropriate responses
