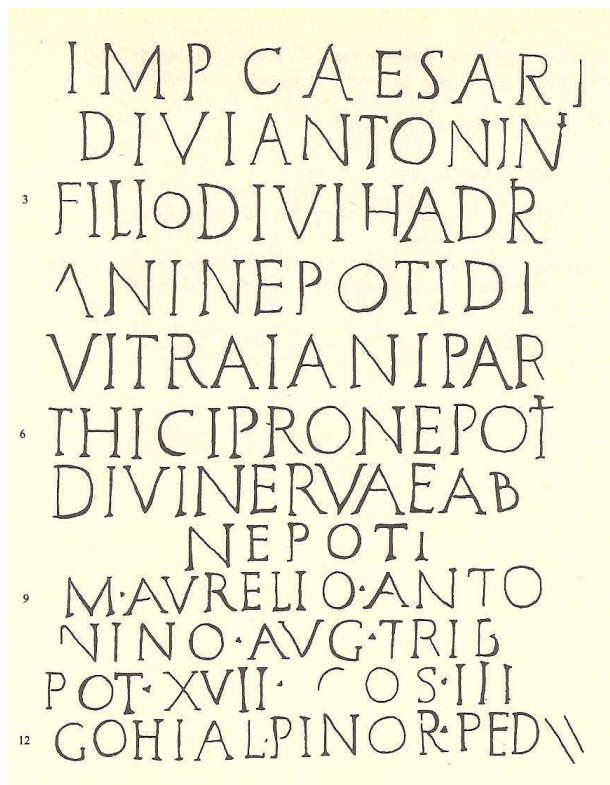


LJMgrB49 Latin inscriptions in Pannonia: Form for transcribing inscriptions

Transcribe the text of the following inscription in minuscule type (case-sensitive, with word-divisions) based on the drawing, using the epigraphic conventions as follows: (abc) parentheses, to complete abbreviations, e.g. leg(ionis); [abc] square brackets, for letters lost or illegible, restored by conjecture, e.g. [Sep]timio; <abc> angle brackets, for letters accidentally omitted by the engraver, e.g. fili<a>e, or for correct letters inserted by the editor to replace wrong ones, e.g. <f>ilio for EILIO (please, in the transcription indicate the "correct" reading, and mention the correction you made in the "Notes" section); {abc} curly brackets, for superfluous letters inscribed on the stone, e.g. Q{a}vartus; [[abc]] double square brackets, for letters deliberately erased, for example following *damnatio memoriae*, e.g. [[Commodus]]; ~ ligature tie, for denoting ligatures resolved, e.g. filiãe; / slash, to indicate line divisions (line-numbers have to be given only for every fifth line).
