
Speech Trainer 3D








Speech Trainer 3-D is a unique application created specifically to help individuals with speech-sound disorders and English language learners. It provides an animated video model, with both side and front view, of 32 English language sounds: 23 consonants





In addition to the animated video model, Speech Trainer 3-D uses the camera function built into the iPad 2 and higher to allow the learner to see a side-by-side picture of the model and his or her own face

Silence is detected to automatically insert pauses for playback and record.




