- 1. Describe the **characters** (how many, silent x speaking, entrances, exits, movement, what they are like, what they want, what they (not) know/realize).
- 2. Describe the **structure** and **dramatic techniques** employed (what are the smaller units of meaning in the scene? breaking points, repetitions why?, stichomythia).
- 3. Examples of dramatic irony, ambivalence and double meaning.
- 4. Where is *hubris* there?
- 5. Discuss the question of **identity**: I argue one of the topics of this scene (and the whole play) is identity (what it is, how it is constructed, who Oedipus is). How would you support this argument?
