UNIT TWO

The 被 bèi structure

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A The 被 bèi structure in Chinese is similar to the passive voice in English. ebrary However, English passive voice sentences are commonly rendered in Chinese as topic—comment sentences. (For further discussion of topic—comment structures, see Unit 7.):

菜吃完了。 cài chī wán le The food has been caten.

教室打扫干净了。 jiàoshì dǎsǎo gānjìng le The classroom has been swept clean.

Note: As a general rule, verbs followed by complements of result (e.g. 吃 chī 'eat' + 完 wán 'to a finish', 打扫 dǎsǎo 'sweep' + 下净 gānjìng 'till clean', etc.) tend to be associated with the sentence particle ? le. (See Units 1 and 8.)

The 被 **bèi** structure comes into play (1) when an 'agent' is introduced into the ebrar sentence or (2) the speaker adopts a narrative stance and describes how something has happened:

(1) 被 bèi with an agent:

菜被我吃完了。 cài bèi wǒ chī wán le The food was finished by me. (我 wǒ - the 'agent')

教室被学生们打扫干净了。 jiàoshì bèi xuéshengmen dǎsǎo gānjìng le The classroom was swept clean by the students. (学生 xuésheng – the 'agent')

(2) 被 bèi in a narrative sentence:

菜被吃完了。 cài bèi chī wán le

The food was eaten (by someone).fc00158cdfe4b679bff9298ed27404b

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教室被打扫干净了。 jiàoshì bèi dǎsǎo ganjìng le The classroom was swept clean (by someone).

Note: In the sentence 築吃完了 cài chī wán le, the speaker takes a commentative stance, observing that the food has been finished and there is none left. By contrast, in the sentence 菜被吃完了 cài bèi chī wán le, the speaker adopts a narrative stance, and is saying what has happened to the food, i.e. it has been eaten by somebody.

B The verb in a 被 bèi sentence, as in a 把 bǎ sentence (see Unit 1), should always be followed by a complement:

电视机被弟弟弄坏了。

diànshìjī bèi dìdi nòng huài le (坏 huài result complement) The TV set was damaged by (my) younger brother.

窗户都被打开了。 chuānghu dou bèi dǎ kāi le (开 kāi result complement) All the windows had been opened.

钱被藏在抽屉里。

qián bèi cáng zài chōuti li (在 . . . 里 zài . . . li location complement) The money was kept in a drawer.

小猫被爸爸抱在怀里。

xiǎo māo bèi bàba bào zài huái li (在 . . . 里 zài . . . li location complement) Father held the kitten in his arms. (lit. The kitten was held in his arms by Father.)

750015礼物被装进一个漂亮的盒子里去了。45

lǐwù bèi zhuāng jìn yī gè piàoliang de hézi li qù le (进 . . . 去 jìn . . . qù direction complement)

The gift was put into an attractive box.

狼被赶出村子去。

láng bèi gắn chủ cũnzi qù (出 ... 去 chủ ... qù direction complement) The wolf was driven away from the village.

她被爸爸批评了儿次。

tā bèi bàba pīpíng le jǐ cì (几次 jǐ cì frequency complement) She was reprimanded several times by her father.

犯人被关了三年。

fànrén bèi guān le sān nián (三年 sān nián duration complement)

The criminal was imprisoned for three years. 158cdfe4b679bff9298ed27404b

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这种画儿被叫作现代画。

zhè/zhèi zhòng huàr bèi jiào zuò xiàndài huà (作 zuò . . . as complement) This style of painting is called Modern Art.

这个骗子被我当成好人。

zhè/zhèi gè piànzi bèi wǒ dàng chéng hǎo rén (成 chéng . . . as complement) This cheat was taken by me to be an honest person.

头发被剪得太短了。

tóufa bèi jiǎn de tài duǎn le (manner/resultant state 得 de phrase as complement)

His/her hair was (cut) too short.

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她被雨淋得衣服都湿透了。

tā bèi yǔ lín de yīfu dōu shī tòu le (得 de clause as complement)

She was soaked to the skin by the rain.

(lit. She was drenched so much by the rain that her clothes were all soaked.)

Note: It can be seen from the last two examples that adjectival complements modified by degree adverbs \pm tài 'too' or degree complement \pm tòu 'through and through', etc. generally require the use of sentence particle \uparrow le.

C In spoken Chinese or in colloquial writing, 被 **bèi** is often replaced by 让 **ràng** or 叫 **jiào**, but only if an agent is involved. In these cases 给 **gěi** may also be used directly before the verb:

衣服让孩子 (给) 弄脏了。 yīfu ràng háizi (gěi) nòng zāng le The child made his/her clothes dirty.

7fc0015 强盗叫警察 (给) 抓住了。 qiángdào jiào jǐngchá (gěi) zhuā zhù le ebrary The robber was arrested by the police.

Note that 被 bèi does not usually go with 给 gěi:

One does not say:

*强盗被警察(给)抓住了。

qiángdào bèi jingchá (gěi) zhuā zhù le to translate 'The robber was arrested by the police'.

In addition, in colloquial speech, 缙 **géi** itself may be used to replace 被 **bèi** in sentences where the agent is not specified:

强盗给抓住了。 qiángdào gĕi zhuā zhù le The robber was caught.

D It should also be noted that the 被 bèi structure is often used to narrate an unpleasant event:

他被爸爸骂了一顿。 tā bèi bàba mà le yī dùn

He was told off by his father.

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她让老帅批评得哭了起来。 tā ràng lǎoshī pīpíng de kū le qìlái She was criticised so much by the teacher that she began to cry.

花瓶叫小吴 (给) 打破了。 huāpíng jiào xiǎo wú (gěi) dǎ pò le The vase was broken by Xiao Wu.

E The 被 bèi construction, being a narrative sentence about something that has happened, is always negated by 没 (有) méi(yǒu), which is placed immediately before 被 bèi. In a negative 被 bèi sentence, 丁 le, of course, is not present after the complement:

衣服没(行)被雨淋湿。 yīfu méi(yǒu) bèi yǔ lín shī [e4b679bff9298ed27404b] The clothes were not (made) wet by the rain.

小女孩没 (有) 被火烧伤。 xiǎo nǚhái méi(yǒu) bèi huǒ shāo shāng The little girl was not burnt by the fire.

F Adverbials of manner or location in 被 bèi sentences may precede either 被 bèi or the verb. In the latter case, the adverbial becomes more emphatic:

月亮慢慢地被 片乌云遮住了。

yuèliang mànmàn de bèi yī piàn wūyún zhē zhù le The moon was slowly covered by a patch of black clouds.

那些调皮的孩子让校长(给)狠狠地批评了一顿。

nà/nèi xiè tiáopí de háizi ràng xiàozhǎng (gèi) hěnhěn de pīpíng le yī dùn Those naughty children were severely criticised by the head teacher.

小女孩被消防队员从屋子里救了出来。

xiǎo nǚhái bèi xiāofáng duìyuán cóng wūzi li jiù le chūlái The little girl was rescued from the house by the firemen.

Note I: However, monosyllabic referential adverbs like 都 dôu 'all', 'both', 就 jiù 'then', 'soon', 雲 cái 'only', 'then', etc. must always precede 變 bèi:

剩下的饭菜都被(厨师) 倒掉了。

shèng xià de fàncài dou bèi (chúshī) dào diào le All the food that was left over was thrown away (by the cook).

Note 2: A number of examples given in this unit show that complements of direction, frequency and duration can in a narrative tone follow verbs marked by the aspect marker 了 le (e.g. 哭了起来 kū le qīlái 'started to cry'/'weep', 教子出来 jíù le chūlái 'be rescued from (the house)', 骂了一顿 mà le yī dùn 'told (somebody) off severely', 批评了几次 pīpíng le jǐ cì 'reprimanded several times', 美了 年 guān le sān nián 'imprisoned for three years'). However, verbs taking complements of result cannot be interrupted by the aspect marker 了 le, which has to come after the complement. In this situation it therefore often coincides with the sentence particle 了 le at the end of the sentence (e.g. 打破了 dǎ pò le 'be broken', 蛋薄了 dào diào le 'be thrown away', etc.). dfe4b679bff9298ed27404b

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Exercise 2.1

- 9 花儿被插花瓶里了。 huār bèi chā huāpíng li le The flowers were put in a vase.
- 10 行李都让火车给运。 **xíngli dōu ràng huŏchē gěi yùn** 4b679bff9298ed27404b The luggage was all taken by train.
