## HW for next week, 29 Nov:

This week in class I showed you a few examples of erasures (I will post a few of these on IS too).

Erasures are a visual and kinetic way of thinking about what's important to us in a text. I'd like you to:

- 1. take a 1-page sample of ANY text which you are reading as research for your essay project (a page from another essay, for example, or a webpage related to your topic)
- 2. PRINT OUT a HARD COPY of the page of text, and
- 3. Perform an erasure on it.

I don't recommend just doing this electronically (although you certainly could); it's more fun (and I think more meditative) to do it physically, by hand, on paper. Feel free to get colorful and creative with your erasure methods (any method that hides or obscures the text in some way could work).

Bring your erasures to share next week in class.

And keep working on your essays.
