



Roman religion, gods and priests



Lares, Penates, Manes, Lemures, Genii

- ▶ Lares – guardian deities, their origin is uncertain
- ▶ Penates – house deities to whom Romans sacrificed every day
- ▶ Manes – chthonic deities often relating to death
- ▶ Lemures – spirits of restless deads
- ▶ Genii – general deities, as angels (Christianity)
