



While both 或者(huò zhě,or)and 还是(hái shì,or)link up two words or phrases that indicate different alternatives, the former usually appears in statements, the latter in questions

1.A:你今天晚上做什么? nǐ jīn tiān wǎn shang zuò shén me ? What are you going to do tonight?

B:听音乐或者看电影。
tīng yīn yuè huò zhě kàn diàn yǐng.
Listen to music or watch a movie.

B:看电影或者跳舞都行。
kàn diàn yǐng huò zhě tiào wǔ dōu xíng .
Either seeing a movie or going dancing would be fine with me.

3.A:你喜欢什么颜色的鞋?黑色的还是咖啡色的? nǐ xǐ huan shén me yán sè de xié ?hēi sè de hái shi kā fēi sè de ?

What color shoes do you like? Black or brown ones?

B:黑色的或者咖啡色的我都不喜欢,我喜欢白的。 hēi sè de huò zhě kā fēi sè de wǒ dōu bù xǐ huan,wǒ xǐ huan bái de.

I don't like either black or brown. I like white ones

#### 2 或者(huò zhě,or)and 还是(hái shì,or)

4.明天你去开会或者他去开会都可以。 míng tiān nǐ qù kāi huì huò zhě tā qù kāi huì dōu kě yǐ. Either you or he may attend tomorrow`s meeting.







Sometimes 再(zài)indicates a sequence of actions rather than a repetition.先看电影再吃饭(xiān kàn diàn yǐng zài chī fàn,first go to the movie,then eat) means 先看电影以后吃饭(xiān kàn diàn yǐng yǐ hòu chī fàn,eat after seeing the movie).

1.A:你什么时候给妈妈打电话?
nǐ shén me shí hou gěi mā ma dǎ diàn huà?
When are you going to call Mom?
B:下课以后再打。
xià kè yǐ hòu zài dǎ.

I'll call after class.

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2.我想先打球再去**图书馆。** 

wò xiàng xiān dà qiú zài qù tú shū guàn. I`d like to play ball and then go to the library.

Sometimes 再(zài)indicates a sequence of actions rather than a repetition.先看电影再吃饭(xiān kàn diàn yǐng zài chī fàn,first go to the movie,then eat) means 先看电影以后吃饭(xiān kàn diàn yǐng yǐ hòu chī fàn,eat after seeing the movie).

3.弟弟常先做功课再上网聊天儿。 dì di cháng cháng xiān zuò gōng kè zài shàng wǎng liáo tiānr. My little brother often does his homework first and then chats online

As adverbs,先(xiān)and 再(zài) must come immediately before a verb.They cannot be placed in front of the subject.

4.小王先买东西再吃晚饭。 xiǎo wáng xiān mǎi dōng xi zài chī wǎn fàn. Little Wang will shop first before having dinner.

4a 先小王买东西再吃晚饭。(X) xiān xiǎo wáng mǎi dōng xi zài chī wǎn fàn.





When a noun or noun phrase has become established as a known element in a conversation, it can occur at the beginning of the sentence as the "topic," with the rest of the sentence functioning as a "comment" on it. This forms what is known as a "topic-comment sentence." In such a sentence the object of the verb can be brought forward to serve as the topic of the sentence.

1.A:我昨天买了一枝笔。
wǒ zuó tiān mǎi le yì zhī bǐ.
I bought a pen yesterday.

B:那枝笔你用了吗? nà zhī bǐ nǐ yòng le ma? Have you used that pen?

2.A:你知道我的衬衫在哪儿吗? nǐ zhī dao wǒ de chèn shān zài nǎr ma ?. Do you know where my shirt is?

B:你的衬衫我给你妈妈了。 nǐ de chèn shān wǒ gěi nǐ mā ma le. I gave your shirt to your mother.

3.A:你有朋友吗? nǐ yǒu péng you ma ? Do you have friends?

B:朋友我有很多,可是都不在**这**儿。 péng you wǒ yǒu hěn duō, kě shì dōu bú zài zhèr. I have many friends, but none of them are here.

4.她不想去纽约,可是飞机票她妈妈已经帮她买了。

tā bù xiǎng qù niǔ yuē, kě shì fēi jī piào tā mā ma yǐ jīng bāng tā mǎi le.

She does not want to go to New York, but her mother has already bought the airplane ticket for her.

1.A:你说,明天看电影还是看球? nǐ shuō, míng tiān kàn diàn yǐng hái shi kàn qiú ? What do you think we should watch tomorrow, a movie or a ball game?

B:还是看电影吧。
hái shi kàn diàn yǐng ba .
Let`s see a movie.

2.A:我的车有问题。怎么办? wǒ de chē yǒu wèn tí. zěn me bàn ? There is a problem with my car. What shall we do?

B:那别去听音乐会了。我们还是在家看电视吧。 nà bié qù tīng yīn yuè huì le. wǒ men hái shi zài jiā kàn diàn shì ba. Let`s not go to the concert then. We`d better stay home and watch TV. A:你怎么回家? nǐ zěn me huí jiā ? How do you go home?

B:我坐公共汽车回家。 wǒ zuò gōng gòng qì chē huí jiā. I go home by bus.

2.Taxicabs are called 计程车(jì chéng chē, metered cars) in Taiwan but 出租(汽)车(chū zū[qì]chē) in

mainland China. To take a taxi is 打车(dǎ chē)

A:你怎么去学校?







In a sentence that contains the term 每(měi,every), usually 都(dōu,all)has to be inserted further along in the sentence, immediately in front of the verb.

- 1.他每天晚上都预习课文。
  tā měi tiān wǎn shang dōu yù xí kè wén.
  He studies the lessons in advance every night.
- 2.我每节课都来。 wǒ měi jié kè dōu lái. I come to every class.

In a sentence that contains the term 每(měi,every), usually 都(dōu,all)has to be inserted further along in the sentence, immediately in front of the verb.

- 3.这儿每个人我都认识。 zhèr měi ge rén wǒ dōu rèn shi. I know everyone here.
- 4.常老师的字每个都好看。 cháng lǎo shī de zì měi ge dōu hǎo kàn. Every one of Teacher Chang`s characters looks nice.



- The 要…了(yào...le)structure indicates the imminence of an anticipated action or situation. It also appears in the form of 快要...了(kuài yào...le).
- 1.新年快要到了,我**们给爸爸妈妈写一封信吧。** xīn nián kuài yào dào le, wǒ men gěi bà ba mā ma xiě yì fēng xìn ba . New Year is around the corner. Let's write to Mom and Dad.
- 2.寒假要到了,你要做什么? hán jià yào dào le, nǐ yào zuò shén me ? It`ll be winter break soon. What do you want to do ?

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- 3.电影快要开始了,你买票了吗? diàn yǐng kuài yào kāi shǐ le, nǐ mǎi piào le ma? New Year is around the corner. Let`s write to Mom and Dad.
- 4.快要考试了,我们大家得准备一下。 kuài yào kǎo shì le, wǒ men dà jiā děi zhǔn bèi yí xià. The exam is coming. We have to study for it.
