The counseling process

CP began to emerge at the turn of the century - the earliest clinical psychologists in the USA (Witmer) and later in Europe (Adler) began to establish the first counseling.

# Counselors psychologists in CZECH REPUBLIC work mainly with:

preschool children

elementary school students

high school students

## List of frequently consulting solved the problem:

## **Preschool age:**

- delay in development, intellectual retardation, gifted children, school readiness, laterality,
- social measures,

- educational problems,
- eating disorders,
- sleep disorders,
- anxiety,
- autism spectrum disorders,
- sibling relationships, etc.

## **School age:**

- adaptation to school,
- agitation, learning disabilities,
- ambition, motivation to study,
- emotional disorders,
- behavioral disorders etc.

## **High school students:**

- neuroses, eating disorders,
- first episode psychotic disorders
- Self-esteem, Self-efficacy,
- sexuality,
- relationship problems, the crisis of authority,
- · career choice, etc.

 Some disorderé, syndromé and problemé, like ADHD, CAN syndrome, emotional and behavioral disorderé, eating disorderé, etc. are occure in all stages of development on personality.

 They have different representation, symptoms and intensity...

## CP Relationship**s** to other disciplines

## **Psychotherapy:**

- counseling psychology focuses more on the problems of adaptation rather than a mental disorder and is often focused on specific areas (like educational problems, ADHD syndrome, etc.)
- counseling is a precursor on therapy,
- counseling is focused on actual situation of client...

## **Psychiatry**:

CP often capture the pathology and take a client to the care of a psychiatrist.

## **Neurology:**

Many counseling issues may have a neurological basis...like a enuresis etc.

## **Pediatry**:

- perinatology,
- psychosomatic,
- · obesity,
- genetics,
- psychological effects of somatic diseases, etc.

- Developmental Psychology,
- Special Education,
- Educational Psychology,
- Speech therapy,
- State child-care authorities, Police, Courts ...

# OBJECTIVES of Counseling process:

 prophylaxis stimulation of the client's personal growth and

• corrective function consulting solutions already existing problems.

focus on Self – acceptance,

provide information,

 help formulate realistic plans to solve the problem,

Personality development, etc...

#### **COUNSELLING PROCESS:**

Intervention and psychodiagnostics process is usually realized during 2-3 meetings.

Control: usually after 6 month or a year from first visit.

### FREQUENTLY EXPECTED FROM CLIENT:

- revamp child,
- confirm his own opinion,
- get advice,
- make sure that everything is "fine,,,
- · confide.
