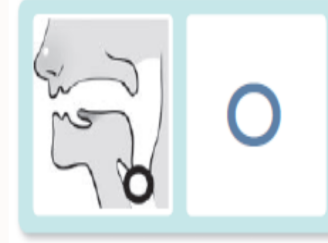

ㅜㅓ [wae] = ㅜㅓ + ㅏ

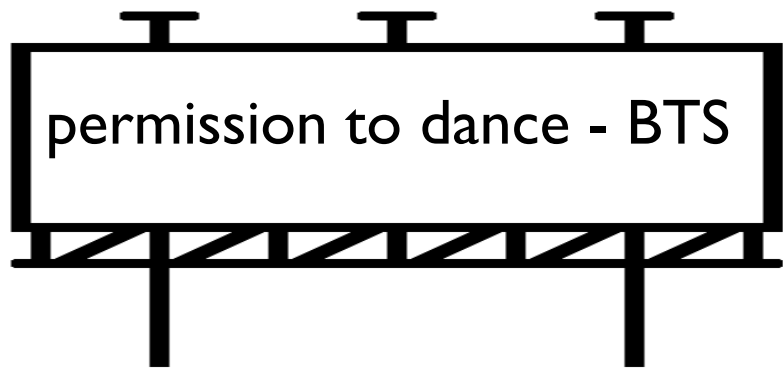
