(3) Left right asymmetry:

Non-isomorphic orders are only found after the lexical head

Universal 20. When any or all of the items (demonstrative, numeral, and descriptive adjective) precede the noun, they are always found in that order. If they follow, the order is either the same or its exact opposite.

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 - b. location = noun + place marker (*in, on, at, above, ...*)

Language variation beyond ordering

- b. Deuv-**ra-m** Luk-**ina-m** ka-va ga-v.
house-LOC-DAT Luke-LOC-DAT I-TOP go-PRES
'I go to Luke's house.'
- c. Ovla deuv-**ra** ka-**ina** dihel-v.
knife house-LOC I-LOC exist-PRES
'The knife is at my house' (lit. at the house at me).

Language variation beyond ordering

(9) Expressing Path in Cz

- a. Nůž je v šuflíku
knife is in drawer
'The knowf is in the drawer'

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he.put knife into drawer
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do = PATH+PLACE
- c. Vzal nůž z šuflíku
he.took knife out.of drawer
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Petr is.standing by tree
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'Petr lazily walked to the tree.'

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- c. Petr utíkal od stromu.
Petr ran away from the tree.
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- ▶ MANNER+MOTION+PATH+PLACE+THING

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- ▶ the emergence of MANNER
- ▶ MANNER+MOTION+PATH+PLACE+THING
- ▶ Manner+Motion > Path+Place > Thing

Verb framed languages

- (1) a. The boat floated into the cave.
- b. *La barca galleggiò nella grotta.
the boat floated in.the cave
'The boat floated **into** the cave.'
- c. La barca galleggiò nella grotta.
the boat floated in.the cave
'The boat floated **in** the cave.'
- d. La barca entrò nella grotta galleggiando.
the boat entered into.the cave floating
'The boat entered the cave, floating.'

Language variation beyond ordering

(11) MANNER PATH PLACE THING

- a. entered in cave floating
Path Place goal manner
- b. plul do jeskyně
manner path+place ground

Language variation beyond ordering

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- ▶ Some markers conflate multiple meanings (fusion – agglutination)
- ▶ The argument is still out there

Recap

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Case and number

- (12) Greenberg's Universal 39 (Greenberg 1963: 75)
Where morphemes of both number and case are present and both follow or both precede the noun base, the expression of number almost always comes between the noun base and the expression of case.


Turkish

 DAT =child
 b. **sa=mga=bata**

Case and number




Classical Armenian




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
