



The **memex** (originally coined "at random",<sup>[1]</sup> though sometimes said to be a portmanteau of "memory" and "index"<sup>[2]</sup>) is the name of the hypothetical protohypertext system that Vannevar Bush described in his 1945 *The Atlantic Monthly* article "As We May Think". Bush envisioned the memex as a device in which individuals would compress and store all of their books, records, and communications, "mechanized so that it may be consulted with exceeding speed and flexibility". The memex would provide an "enlarged intimate supplement to one's memory".<sup>[3]</sup> The concept of the memex influenced the development of early hypertext systems (eventually leading to the creation of the World Wide Web) and personal knowledge base software.<sup>[4]</sup> The hypothetical implementation depicted by

Bush for the purpose of concrete illustration was based upon a document bookmark list of static microfilm pages and lacked a true hyper structure beyond the common textual format. Early electronic limits and lacked directly upon it.
