	Plasma technolgy is (already) an environmental technology at all!
	 NOx, SOx, VOCs and other gaseous contaminants can be decomposed in non-thermal plasmas (NTPs) via "radical based" plasma chemistry. Exhaust treatment by means of NTP is especially suited for low concentrations in small and medium gas flows. Applicability/feasibility is determined by the specific situation (type and amount of contaminants, properties of gas flow) and has to consider effectivity and selectivity.
	 There is a large potential for hybrid/catalytic/heterogenous methods. Generation of plasma at or in water is possible and leads to antimicrobial and chemical effects.
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
