Distinguish: What causes the problem now? x What caused the problem? (= in the past)

What may cause the problem now? x What may have caused the problem? (= in the past)

Ask these questions:

1. Co způsobuje / může způsobit sesuvy půdy?.....
2. Co způsobilo sesuv půdy?.....
3. Co asi způsobilo sesuvy půdy?.....
4. Čím může být sesuv půdy způsoben?.....
5. Čím mohl být sesuv půdy způsoben?.....

Practice the following sentence transformations:

Something may appear to be / not to be... (=now)

1. In a landslide, it may appear that gravity is the only agent of erosion.

In a landslide, gravity may appear

Something is unlikely to have happened. (= in the past)

1. It is not probable that gravity caused the rockslide.

Gravity is unlikely

An agent (=a cause) must/could/may/might (not) have caused an event (=effect)

1. Gravity probably did not cause the rockslide. (=možná, že ne)
Gravity may notthe rockslide.

2. It is obvious that gravity did not cause the rockslide. (=určitě ne)
Gravity could notthe rockslide.

3. It is sure that gravity caused the rockslide. (=určitě ano)
Gravity mustthe rockslide.

An event (=effect) may/might/can/could be caused by... =now)

1. It is possible that gravity starts the rockslide.
The rockslide cangravity.

An event (=effect) may/might/can/could have been caused by... =in the past)

1. It is possible that rainwater running off the mountainside started the rockslide.
The landslide couldrainwater.
